DESCRIPTION

H3K36me2 (histone H3 lysine 36 dimethylation) Recombinant Nucleosome, Biotinylated consists of 147 base pairs of DNA wrapped around an octamer of core histone proteins (two each of H2A, H2B, H3.1, and H4) to form a nucleosome, the basic repeating unit of chromatin. The 147 bp 601 sequence, identified by Lowary and Widom [1], has high affinity for histone octamers and is useful for nucleosome assembly. H3K36me2 nucleosome contains dimethylated lysine at position 36 on histone H3.1. The DNA contains a 5' biotin-TEG group.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Storage Formulation Stable for six months at -80°C from date of receipt. For best results, aliquot and avoid freeze/thaws. 1.0 mg/mL mononucleosome in 20 μ L 10 mM Tris HCl pH 7.5, 25 mM NaCl, 1 mM EDTA, 2 mM DTT, 20% glycerol (10.9 μ g protein, 20 μ g DNA + protein).

APPLICATION NOTES

H3K36me2 nucleosome is highly purified and suitable for a variety of applications, including use as a substrate in enzyme assays, high-throughput screening and inhibitor testing, chromatin binding studies, protein-protein interaction assays, structural studies, and in effector protein binding experiments. For a corresponding unmodified control, we recommend EpiCypher 16-0006.




FIGURE 1 Western blot data. Western Analysis of H3K36me2 nucleosome. Top Panel: Unmodified (EpiCypher 16-0006; Lane 1) and H3K36me2 (Lane 2) nucleosomes were probed with an anti-H3K36me2 antibody and analyzed via enhanced chemiluminescence (ECL) readout. Only the H3K36me2 sample produced a detectable signal. Bottom Panel: Detail from Coomassie stained gel showing unmodified (Lane 1) and H3K36me2 (Lane 2) nucleosomes.




FIGURE 2 Mass spec data. Synthetic H3K36me2 histone analyzed by high resolution mass spectrometry. Expected mass = 15,300.9 Da. Determined mass = 15,300.96 Da.




FIGURE 3 Protein gel data. Coomassie stained SDS-PAGE gel of proteins in H3K36me2 nucleosome (1 μ g) demonstrates the purity of histones in the preparation. Sizes of molecular weight markers and positions of the core histones (H2A, H2B, H3K36me2, and H4) are indicated.




FIGURE 4 DNA gel data. H3K36me2 nucleosome resolved via native PAGE and stained with ethidium bromide to visualize DNA. Lane 1: Free DNA (EpiCypher 18-0005; 100 ng). Lane 2: Intact H3K36me2 nucleosomes (400 ng).
